

Wing Trim Consent Form

I understand that clipping the wing feathers on my bird will **MINIMIZE** the bird's ability to fly; birds are meant to fly. Occasionally a bird will be able to fly even with **ALL** the wing feathers clipped. Birds have also been known to fly with part of one wing amputates. We can clip more feathers if the bird is still able to get lift after what we clip today. What we are trying to achieve is a bird that will glide to the floor, not drop like a rock (which can potentially injure legs, wings, keel, etc.)

We **NEVER** advise letting your bird loose outside.
